Temecula Cemetery District Field Operations Conduct and Disciplinary

Policy-4090

Subject: Policy on Field Operations Conduct, Accountability, and Disciplinary Procedures

Purpose

The Temecula Cemetery District is committed to upholding the highest standards of professionalism, efficiency, and respect in maintaining our cemetery grounds to serve the community with dignity. This policy establishes expectations for field operations employees under the supervision of the foreman to ensure active engagement in assigned duties, accountability for whereabouts, and compliance with the district's operational standards and applicable California laws. This policy is enacted in accordance with the Temecula Cemetery District's guidelines and is subject to approval by District management.

Scope

This policy applies to all field operations employees of the Temecula Public Cemetery District under the direct supervision of the foreman. It addresses conduct related to fieldwork, accountability, and adherence to workplace responsibilities during paid hours.

Policy Statement

Effective immediately, all field operations employees are required to actively participate in assigned tasks, maintain open communication with the foreman regarding their whereabouts within the cemetery premises, and refrain from engaging in unapproved activities during work hours. Unauthorized absences from assigned work areas, failure to perform duties, or deliberate avoidance of work (e.g., hiding or "killing time") will result in progressive disciplinary action. This policy ensures operational efficiency, upholds the district's mission, and complies with California labor laws and cemetery district regulations.

Employee Responsibilities

1. Notification of Whereabouts: Employees must promptly notify the foreman of their location within the cemetery premises during work

hours. Failure to report whereabouts constitutes a violation of this policy.

- 2. Engagement in Assigned Duties: Employees are expected to diligently perform assigned field tasks, including but not limited to grounds maintenance, equipment operation, and other duties as directed by the foreman. Deliberately avoiding work or engaging in non-work-related activities during paid hours is prohibited.
- 3. **Professional Conduct**: Employees shall conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the solemnity and professionalism required for cemetery operations, consistent with the Temecula Cemetery District's standards and the California Health and Safety Code.

Disciplinary Procedures

To ensure compliance, the following progressive disciplinary measures will be enforced, subject to review and approval by Temecula Cemetery District management:

- 1. **First Violation**: Any employee found absent from their assigned work area without notifying the foreman or engaging in unapproved activities will be sent home for the remainder of the workday without pay. This action aligns with California Labor Code Section 2922, which permits disciplinary measures for failure to perform duties, and is consistent with wage and hour laws for non-exempt employees.
- 2. **Second Violation**: A subsequent violation will result in a recommendation to District management for a suspension without pay for a minimum of three (3) days. The duration may be extended based on the severity of the infraction, as permitted under California labor laws for disciplinary suspensions of non-exempt employees.
- 3. **Further Violations**: Repeated violations may lead to further disciplinary actions, and or for termination, in accordance with California's at-will employment doctrine (Labor Code Section 2922) and Temecula Cemetery District policies.

All disciplinary actions will be documented and reported to District management to ensure transparency and compliance with applicable regulations.

Legal Framework

This policy is grounded in the following California laws and regulations, which align with the Temecula Cemetery District's operational standards:

- California Labor Code Section 2922: Establishes at-will employment, allowing supervisors to enforce workplace rules and discipline employees for non-compliance, provided actions align with District policies and do not violate protected rights.
- California Labor Code Section 6403: Prohibits employees from willfully neglecting their duties, including failure to engage in assigned tasks or being absent without authorization.
- California Health and Safety Code Sections 9000 et seq.: Governs public cemetery districts, emphasizing the responsibility of employees to perform duties that maintain the operational integrity and dignity of the cemetery.
- Business and Professions Code Sections 9600 et seq.: Regulates cemetery operations, requiring employees to adhere to professional standards under the oversight of the Cemetery.
- California Labor Code Section 558: Authorizes penalties for wage and hour violations, including fines of \$50 for initial violations and \$100 for subsequent violations, which may apply to employees who fail to perform duties during paid hours.

Consequences of Non-Compliance

Non-compliance with this policy undermines the Temecula Cemetery District's mission to provide respectful and efficient cemetery services. Violations may result in financial penalties for the district, operational disruptions, and diminished community trust. Employees who fail to adhere to this policy may face disciplinary actions as outlined above, in addition to potential fines under California Labor Code Section 558 for wage and hour violations. All actions will be documented and subject to review by District management to ensure fairness and compliance.

Alignment with Temecula Cemetery District Guidelines

This policy adheres to the Temecula Cemetery District's commitment to operational excellence, employee accountability, and community service. It is designed to complement existing District policies and is subject to approval by the district's management or board of trustees. Employees are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy alongside other District guidelines governing workplace conduct.
